

# ENROLLMENT FEES

## Required Fees:

**A. Standard Enrollment Fee: \$36 per unit**

This fee is established by the State of California and is subject to change.

**B. Health Services Fee: \$17 per semester; \$14 summer session**

This fee helps support campus health services including limited student accident insurance. All students pay this fee.

**C. Transportation Fee: \$1.50 per unit**

Ride the bus and do your part to maintain the pristine environment of Plumas County. This fee was voted in by the general student body in April 1999. It entitles the pass holder to unlimited bus service within Plumas County through the Plumas County Transit Systems. Schedules are available on campus.

**D. Parking Permit: \$20 per semester; \$5 summer session**

All students attending classes at the FRC Quincy campus must purchase a parking permit.

**E. Nonresident Tuition: \$199/ unit + \$36/ unit (subject to change) standard enrollment fee**

Students who have not been legal residents of California for a full year prior to enrolling and who are enrolling for 3.5 units or more, must pay the Nonresident Tuition fee in addition to the Standard Enrollment, Health, and Transportation fees.

**F. Nevada Residents: \$42 per unit**

Under a special "Good Neighbor Policy (SB2000)" Nevada residents may qualify for a reduced tuition/enrollment fee of \$42 per unit. Contact the Admissions and Records Office to obtain information on the criteria and process to apply for this reduced fee. The Health and Transportation fees are also required of Good Neighbor students.

**G. International Student Fee: \$199/ unit + \$36/ unit (subject to change) standard enrollment fee**

International students must pay the International Student Fee in addition to the Standard Enrollment, Health, and Transportation fees.

## Optional Fees:

**Computer Printing Fee: \$5 per 100 pages**

Optional payment of this fee entitles students to use the printers associated with the Academic Computing Network (printers connected to FRC computers). The college will contribute 50 pages when a student account is opened; additional pages may be purchased throughout the semester in increments of 100 pages. The computing fee is non refundable.

**Credit by Exam: \$20 per unit**

Students who are currently enrolled in at least one course and who have completed 12 units at FRC with a 2.0 GPA in all college units attempted are eligible to seek "credit by examination" in a maximum of two courses. Students will be assessed a per unit fee for credits earned by exam at the time of registration.

## Withdrawals and Financial Aid

Students who are receiving financial aid funds must consult with the Financial Aid and Student Account offices prior to withdrawing from school regarding refunds or repayments of grant or loan assistance received for that academic term. If a Title IV financial aid recipient withdraws from school during a Payment period, the grant or loan assistance received is subject to federal refund and repayment provisions. This also applies to financial aid recipients who are dropped from classes by their instructors.
