### ***What are Community Education Classes at FRC?***

Community Education courses are not-for-credit classes that bring community members together to link community needs and College resources in a manner that helps people to help themselves and to raise the quality of life in our communities. Community Education offers three sessions each year with a wide variety of affordable courses designed to meet the needs of the community. From vocational classes to arts and crafts, Community Education has something for everyone!

### ***Who Can Take Community Education Classes?***

Community education courses are open to learners of all ages (unless the course has age restrictions that are based on requisite skills); all levels of knowledge all the time unless specified in the course description. All learners are encouraged to attend!

### ***How much do Community Education Classes cost?***

Community education course fees range from \$5-\$150 depending on the materials and facilities needed for the class. Some classes will have a materials fee which is payable to the instructor. All course registration fees are payable to Feather River College.
