  - Why you believe your FRC record does not accurately reflect your academic status.
  - Why you plan to enroll at FRC after completing your degree or certificate here or elsewhere?
  - Your short- and long-term educational and employment goals including any transfer plans you have.
  - How many semesters will you take to complete your (new) program at FRC *and to complete any necessary transfer requirements if you plan to transfer?*
- Documentation showing you have officially declared your new program through the Admissions & Records Office at FRC.
- A current Degree Audit and an updated Education Plan outlining specifically which classes you have left to take (*to complete your new FRC degree/certificate and to meet transfer requirements*), as well as documenting how many additional semesters you will need to complete your work at FRC.
- Documentation from the school(s) you plan to transfer to showing the requirements you must satisfy in order to transfer.

- If you have ever taken out student loans, please submit two printouts:
  - The record of your total indebtedness to date from [www.nsls.ed.gov](http://www.nsls.ed.gov)
  - Your anticipated repayment amount for your loan totals to date, found using one of the loan calculators located at <http://studentaid.ed.gov/PORTALSWebApp/students/english/OtherFormsOfRepay.jsp>)

**Appeals will be reviewed by the Financial Aid Appeal Committee on an individual basis and a written response will be emailed and/or mailed.**
