Job Title: Sustainability Intern

DESCRIPTION:

The FRC Sustainability Intern will work closely with the campus Sustainability Coordinator on various college sustainability projects throughout the entire school year. The student will assist with campus recycling efforts, an annual greenhouse gas emissions audit, organizing student environmental activism, the campus bike library and education project, and other social & environmental projects on campus and in the community. The student will also assist as necessary with sustainability-related events and will sit on the Sustainability Steering Committee with community members, faculty, and staff.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES:

The student will perform recycling duties on campus on a weekly basis in coordination with the sustainability coordinator. The student will also be responsible for helping coordinate Student Environmental Association meetings and activities as student interest and opportunities are presented. The student should also be willing to plan, develop, and implement projects in coordination with the sustainability coordinator on a variety of topics as the need arises.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Basic Knowledge of:

Recycling, preferably some background knowledge in sustainability issues (environmental, social, and/or economic)

Skills in:

Organizational skills, basic writing and math, and communication skills are a MUST! Must be able to develop a flexible but regular and reliable schedule with the sustainability coordinator.

DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS:

College-level writing skills, professionalism, an interest in (or better yet, passion for) environmental and social issues, experience with student activism and organizing events

PHYSICAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Individual must be able to walk around campus (up and down the hill a number of times), carry large trash bags with recycling, drive a car, and participate in student & campus events of a physical nature.

WORK SCHEDULE:

Flexible work schedule, but approximately 6 hours per week during normal school hours.
