

### THE STUDENT BODY AT FRC







Feather River College offers so many programs and degrees that are unique as the students who study them. This is a college that prides itself on one-of-a-kind programs and cutting-edge facilities to allow students the best educational experience possible.

FRC is the only California Community College to offer a 4-year bachelor's degree in Equine and Ranch Management. This unique degree combines scientific agricultural ranch management courses with handson horse and beef related disciplines. Students will have daily opportunities to work with horses and livestock while integrating management and business principles into working for, or creating a successful horse enterprise or ranch operation.

Outdoor Recreation Leadership (ORL) is a program designed to provide students with experience through theory, practical application, and technical skills related to teaching and leading outdoor adventure activities. Students who complete the Outdoor Recreation Leadership program will find themselves well prepared to work professionally as outdoor leaders and/or to transfer to four-year schools.

FRC also boasts one of the only working fish hatcheries on its campus, allowing students to get up close and personal with the animals they are studying! The hatchery is capable of raising trout from egg to trophy size, as well as raising a variety of aquarium fishes. These fish are then stocked at local ponds and lakes, allowing FRC students to play a vital role in our local ecosystem.






