## COLLEGE CREDIT FOR ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) TEST

- Official scores need to be sent to the Admissions and Records Office, along with a completed "Transfer Credit Evaluation" form for posting of the college credit on the student's transcript.
- Course credit and units granted at Feather River College may differ from course credit and units granted by a transfer institution.
- Students may earn credit for Advanced Placement (AP) Tests with scores of 3, 4, or 5. AP credit can be used to meet IGETC, CSU GE and Associate degree general education (GE) and/or major requirements

A student who receives AP credit and then takes the equivalent FRC course will have the unit credit for such duplication deducted prior to being awarded the Associate degree. Credit by Advanced Placement exam is noted and listed first on a student's transcript, with units assigned and no grade.

**CSU GE**: The AP examinations may be incorporated into the certification of CSU General Education-Breadth requirements by any certifying institution. All CSU campuses will accept the minimum units show and apply them toward fulfillment of the designated General Education-Breadth area if the examination is included as art of a full or subject-area certification. Please note that individual CSU campuses may choose to grant more units than those specified toward completion of General Education-Breadth requirements.

IGETC: AP exams must be used in the area indicated regardless of where the certifying institution's discipline is located.
