   Please note, out-of-state student tuition fees are different than resident student fees.
- Request a Student Email: All students need a <u>Network Account</u> to receive a student email address, to login
  to computers on campus, and to login to Canvas, the college's learning management system that is used in
  most courses.
- 3. **Secure Housing:** If you plan to live in student housing, complete the <u>Student Housing Application and License Agreement</u> as soon as possible as housing fills quickly.
- Send Transcripts: Send official high school transcripts, official college transcripts or Advanced Placement scores (if applicable) to:
   Feather River College Attn: Admissions & Records, 570 Golden Eagle Ave., Quincy, CA 95971.
- 5. **Complete Online Orientation.** In addition, we strongly encourage all students to attend orientation on campus the Friday before classes begin.
- 6. **Advising/Counseling:** Contact the Advising/Counseling Office at <a href="mailto:frcadvising@frc.edu">frcadvising@frc.edu</a> to set up a virtual meeting with an advisor or counselor to discuss your academic goals. In the virtual meeting you will review transcripts, select courses, and develop a Student Education Plan (SEP) which will identify the courses you will need to take in order to meet your career, degree, and/or transfer goals.
- 7. **Sign Up for Classes:** Login to your <u>MyFRC</u> using the User ID and PIN above. Click the 'Student' tab, then the 'Registration' link, and then 'Add or Drop Classes' link. Confirming a plan for payment of tuition and enrollment fees will be a part of the registration process.
- 8. **FRC App:** Stay current on the activities at FRC with the FRC App. Download the FRC App on the App Store or Google Play. Use your FRC email and password to register on the app as a student.
