May 4 High Mountain Riders Spring Schooling Show

- Show starts at 9:00 a.m.

- All classes \$5
- All riders must be a member of the High Mountain Riders, and complete a liability release form.
- All riders under 18 must wear an ASTI approved helmet to show or be on a horse at the grounds.

May 5 Lost Sierra Versatility Ranch Horse Show

- Show Starts at 9:00 a.m.
- Entries close at 8:30 a.m. day of.
- Entries due to frchorseshow@outlook.com by **April 29, 2024**
- \$25 late fee imposed for late entries
- All riders must be a member of the High Mountain Riders, and complete a liability release form.
- All riders under 18 must wear an ASTI approved helmet to show or be on a horse at the grounds.

Stalls and Arrival

- Trailers should come in and park on the south side of the arena, which is near the main entrance to the fairgrounds.
- Stalls are on the other side of the "Grandstands" (see map)
- We will be sharing the facility with another group, so no horses are allowed on the grass RV camping area near the arena.
- Bring your own shavings.

Awards:

- Class awards are per class/per division.
- High Point Awards go to highest combination of points in each division.
- Must compete in at least 4 out of 5 classes to qualify for the High Point award.
- Ties will be broken by highest score in ranch riding class
- Prizes will not be shipped, must be picked up.

Divisions/Classes:

- The show will feature the following classes:
 - Working Western Rail
 - Ranch Riding
 - Ranch Reining

- Ranch Trail*
- Ranch Rail Pattern*
- Rail/Trail Jackpot*- Runs concurrently with Ranch Rail & Ranch Trail classes
 - must enter in both classes to be eligible for Jackpot Payout
 - Payout dependent on entries
- Divisions: Open, Amateur, Novice Amateur, Youth, Walk/Trot
- Show will follow AQHA rules

Conduct and Show Management:

- Show Management reserves the right to ask anyone to leave if they deem the horses or rider’s conduct is violent, negative or dangerous to the fellow competitors and spectators.
- Abuse will not be tolerated, and individuals will be asked to leave
 - If asked to leave, class fees will not be refunded.
- Judge and show management decisions are final.
- Please note: The HMR show and the Lost Sierra show are two different shows, and do not include the same divisions, prizes or classes. Points earned do not cross over
