

Division	LSVRH Schooling Show Eligibility for Participation
Open	Any professional or no professional with any horse regardless of past earnings or accomplishments
Amateur	<p>For the last three years has not:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shown, judged, trained or assisted in training a horse for remuneration, monetary or otherwise, either directly or indirectly. Payment of entry fees and/or expenses by anyone other than the amateur, the amateur's "Immediate Family" as defined herein or an amateur's collegiate team and/or nationally sponsored team is considered remuneration. • Instructed another person in riding, driving, training or showing a horse for remuneration. • Held any professional judges card, or professional membership accreditation.
Novice- Amateur	<p>Rider adheres to rules listed in the Amateur Eligibility and also: Rider has not won any of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Overall High Point, Reserve High Point, or Champion/Reserve Champion in any western discipline show circuit with 5 or more participants in the division. • Year-End- High Point or Year- End Championship in any western discipline with 5 or more participants in the division. • 10 lifetime points in any breed association for a western discipline. • \$500 or more in earnings in any national organization for a western discipline. <p>Riders may ride horses not owned by them, and with one or two hands in any legal western bit. May not cross enter any other event.</p>
Youth	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rider is 8 through 18 as of January first of the current show year. • May not cross enter any other event.
Walk/Trot	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • May not have shown in any competition where loping or cow work was involved (regardless of discipline). • Ineligible once rider wins a circuit or year-end-high point award. • Riders may ride horses not owned by them, and with one or two hands in any legal western bit. • May not cross enter any other division. • Eligible to open, amateur or youth riders
Junior Horse Subdivision	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be entered in another division that entails loping • Horse must be at least three, but no older than 5 as of Jan 1st.
