Complete the CADAA (California Dream Act Application) online at dream.csac.ca.gov to apply.

The 2024-2025 CADAA application will be available in December 2023

Priority Deadline: April 2, 2024 (students attending community colleges can apply until September 2, 2024)

Required Information

Must meet AB 540/SB 68 requirements. U visa holders and students with TPS are also eligible. T visa holders should apply
through FAFSA
Create a username and password for the Dream Act Application
2022 Tax information (if your taxes are not complete indicate "Will File" and use estimated earnings. Login once taxes are
completed to update)
If you are a non-tax filer, indicate "Will not file" and list all untaxed income for the household
List all colleges and universities where you applied
Submit your CA Dream Act Application and review the confirmation page to check for errors
Ensure your parent signs the application, if required.
Verify your GPA has been submitted to the CA Student Aid Commission before the deadline
Check the online portal at each college or university for information regarding your financial aid award

Note: Each time a change is made to your application, you must resubmit it and your parent must re-sign using their pin.
